## CONSTRUCTION OF ADDITIONAL AIRCRAFT APRON AT PARO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (VQPR)

### 1 INTRODUCTION

With effect from 08 January 2026 at 1100 UTC until 19 July 2026 at 1100 UTC, this AIP Supplement notifies all concerned of the construction of an additional aircraft apron located near Taxiway T and in close proximity to the Cargo Terminal Area at Paro International Airport (VQPR).

The layout of the construction area is provided in Attachment A.

### 2 CONSTRUCTION DETAILS

#### 2.1. Location of the construction area

Near Taxiway T and in proximity to the Cargo Terminal Area.

#### 2.2. Scope of work

The construction activities will include, but are not limited to:

- Earthwork
- Granular Sub-Base (GSB)
- Wet Mix Macadam (WMM)
- Plain Cement Concrete (PCC)
- Reinforced Cement Concrete (RCC)
- Installation of sub-surface drainage
- Apron shoulder construction
- Pavement marking and painting

#### 2.3. Period

From 08 January 2026 at 1100 UTC until 19 July 2026 at 1100 UTC.

#### 2.4. Safety arrangements

Worksite boundaries will be marked with cones, barricades, reflective markers, and safety fencing as applicable.

### 3 OTHERS

#### 3.1. Operational caution

Flight crews, ATC, and Ground crews shall exercise caution due to the presence of personnel, construction equipment, and vehicles at the construction area.

#### 3.2. Operating arrangements

Any closure or operational restriction of Taxiway T, if required, will be promulgated by NOTAM.
